Notes: Be at the service by 10am, bus will depart at 10:30 am - Will return around 2:00 pm.




Wednesday, 8 April 2026

Notes: The activity will start from 10am




Thursday, 9 April 2026

Notes: Please ensure children wear comfortable clothes and closed toe shoes, bring a hat, and a water bottle.




Monday, 13 April 2026

Notes: Be at the service by 10am, bus will depart at 10:30 and return by 1:30




Friday, 17 April 2026

Program notes:

- All excursion risk assessments, transport procedures, and supervision plans are in place and available upon request. Ratios are maintained at all times.

- Children must bring packed morning tea and lunch unless otherwise stated. No nuts or seafood products are permitted. Afternoon tea is provided and the menu is displayed at the service.
- Breakfast is provided from 7:00am to 8:30am.
- Please ensure children bring a sun-safe hat and water bottle daily.
- Comfortable clothing suitable for physical and messy play is required. Closed-toe shoes must be worn on all excursion days.
- All dietary requirements and medical needs are managed according to service policies.
- Families will be notified via email if any activity is affected by weather or unforeseen circumstances. A wet weather backup plan is always in place.
