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Please Note:

- Policies and procedures for transporting children & risk management plans for excursions/incursions are in place and available at the service or by request.

- Please ensure you arrive to the program with at least 20 minutes before excursion departure times and sign the permission form which will be available upon entry or at the sign in table .
- An Afternoon Tea and Late snacks will be provided by the service. Morning Tea and Lunch will need to be brought from home. Please avoid nuts, seafood and fish products if possible as our service may have children with anaphylactic to these ingredients attending.
- If an outdoor excursion is postponed due to weather condition, the parents will be notified and there will a plan in place to ensure sufficient indoor activities for children to keep them engaged productively.
- A change of clothes for young children need to be packed in case of emergency.
- Bike and scooter are allowed but make sure to send the safety gear like helmets.
