Additional Information

- Children are to bring a water bottle, hat, morning tea and lunch, enclosed shoes for excursions is preferred, jumper for colder weather.
- Policies and procedures for transporting children & risk management plans for excursions/incursions are in place and available at the service or by request. All children must attend the excursion if attending that day, no educators will be present at the service during excursion times.
- A daily activity plan with multiple experiences is conducted throughout each day. This includes craft, outdoor play, group games, project-based learning, and more. Age-appropriate activities are planned with consideration the competency of each age group.
- Please ensure you arrive to the program with at least 20 minutes before excursion departure times and sign the permission form which will be available upon entry or at the sign in table
- Morning Tea (9:30am) and Lunch (12:30pm) will need to be brought from home. Our service is allergy aware, please avoid nuts (i.e., Nutella, nut bars, peanut butter). Our service will have children anaphylactic to these ingredients attending. Breakfast is not provided. An Afternoon Tea snack will be provided by the service (3:00pm)
- If an outdoor excursion is postponed due to wet weather, a wet weather plan is in place to ensure sufficient indoor activities are planned for that day. Families will be emailed asap if a planned activity is unable to go ahead due to unexpected events or change in schedule.
