Week-Long Projects

Minecraft Coding:

Children can engage in a project using Minecraft's 'education edition' to learn the basics of coding and computer literacy concepts. Minecraft Education Edition is a tool developed by Minecraft to provide educators with a fun way to engage children in coding and stem learning experiences. Children will work together to complete a project by either taking on one of Minecraft's build challenges or identifying one of their own! This project will take place over the two weeks and children will be given the opportunity to work on this throughout the program, as well as be able to present their project to their peers and families.



Loose Parts Play:

Loose parts play is a type of play that supports invention, divergent thinking, problem solving and offers a sense of wonder to children. They are materials that can be moved, carried, combined, redesigned, lined up, and taken apart and put back together in multiple ways. Over the weeks, children will either work in small groups or individually to create. Whether it be building the tallest tower in the world or the smallest café, children will work together to strategically construct or simply participate in outdoor imaginary play. Items will be purchased (and sanitised) from the Green Shed, but we are more than happy to accept donations of unwanted junk from our families!



Textiles:

Textiles and sewing has many benefits for children. It gets them working on planning and problem solving. It increases fine motor and gets children building on their nummary skills. It also gives the children an opportunity to work on a project and create something they are proud of. For this school holidays the children will be working on planning and completing a textiles project. The children will all decided what they want to make, whether that be a costume, a pillowcase, a library book bag, a heat pack or even clothing like pants or a dress! Our amazing educators will guide the children to become sewing masters!



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POLICIES AND GUIDELINES

Please note:

- Policies and procedures for transporting children & risk management plans for excursions/incursions are in place and available at the service or by request.
- Families will be emailed asap if a planned activity is unable to go ahead due to unexpected events, or for a change in excursion/incursion schedules
- Please ensure you arrive to the program with at least 20 minutes before excursion departure times and sign the permission form which will be available upon entry or at the sign in table

- If an outdoor excursion is postponed due to wet weather, a wet weather plan is in place to ensure sufficient indoor activities are planned for that day

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
