Week 1 Construction 11th- 14th April

Children will be having the chance to design, decorate and put together their own wooden cars, racetracks and other projects using the left-over wood. They will be making individual and group projects. They will be learning to safely how to use a variety of hand tool. This is only the start of what they will be doing long term.



Week 2 Loose Parts play 17th-21st April

Loose parts play is a type of play that supports invention, divergent thinking, problem solving and offers a sense of wonder to children. They are materials that can be moved, carried, combined, redesigned, lined up, and taken apart and put back together in multiple ways. Over the weeks, children will either work in small groups or individually to create. Whether it be building the tallest tower in the world or the smallest café, children will work together to strategically construct or simply participate in outdoor imaginary play.
